Sonny Boy!

Sonny's story begins in April of this year at a 20+ feral cat colony located in East Carnegie. One of our foster parents and expert trappers "Amy M." began to trap, vaccinate, and spay/neuter all of the cats in this colony when she noticed a very dirty and injured orange tabby. Amy named him "Sonny" and decided he was friendly enough to be eventually placed into a "foster to adopt" home. She was never so certain of that decision as when she noticed that he was depressed and had the look of an animal who had lost all hope!

Amy took him home and placed him in a big cage with food and litter. She saw that he was very lethargic and barely moved for weeks. He was so scared of anyone touching him. Poor Sonny just did not seem interested in anything. He did not play with toys and barely ate any food. Eventually Sonny was moved from a cage to a spare room after about three weeks to encourage him to move around. Amy then transferred him to another foster home in the hopes that this foster parent would work with him to build the kind of trust that Sonny desperately needed. Sonny came around a little bit but nothing like we expected.

In the meantime, we took him to Animal Friends to be tested and vetted. Sonny also had major flea bites and skin rashes and his one ear was crinkled due to severe ear mites.

Sonny received another blow when he tested positive for FIV, but as all of us cat lovers know, FIV can be handled. FIV is mainly a weakened immune system and the cat MUST be kept indoors for the rest of his life. Upper respiratory infections can become life-threatening. There is absolutely no danger to other cats as long as the cats are spayed/neutered.



All of us at FosterCat thought that finally Sonny was in the clear and then another obstacle emerged...Sonny had three cracked teeth which had to be removed. We will never know how he sustained these injuries or the torment that Sonny has seen in his short life. It is interesting to note that one of the other cats in the colony also had cracked front teeth.

Finally, after months of convalescence, Sonny was placed with a wonderful girl named "Vanessa H." Vanessa heard about Sonny (now "Arthur Weasley") and immediately wanted to foster him. It didn't take long for Vanessa to contact me and let me know she was NEVER going to part with Sonny. I am thrilled to say that Sonny has made remarkable progress! He wagged his tail

for the very first time since we rescued him. He progressed to playing, cuddling and chasing his tail. For the very first time, Sonny now knows what real love is all about! Vanessa reports that he sleeps and snuggles with her every night and just can't be near her enough. Vanessa also reports that her other cats are gradually warming up to Sonny, and she assured me that he is in his FOREVER HOME! As Amy reported to me recently, "it took the effort of a village of cat rescuers to save a life." That my friends is what FosterCat is all about!

Our mission is to develop and sustain an organization to provide temporary foster care for cats and kittens in private homes until permanent homes can be found.

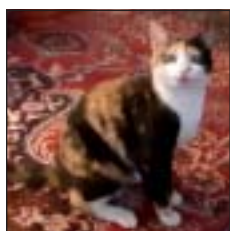

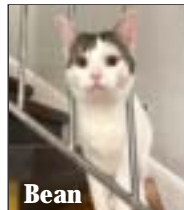
Jefferson is doing really well and is getting along with his sister Audrey (he's still learning her boundaries). Thanks for trusting us. He's a wonderful little guy!

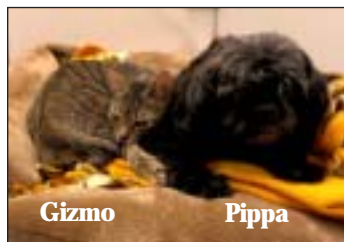
